PART C CHANGES TO THE PROJECT MANUAL

 23 73 13 – Air Handling Units, Part 2 Products, Article 2.2 Miscellaneous Requirements, Add Item O to read:

"Each vertical air handling unit configured with the fan section mounted above or on top of the coil sections shall be provided with a factory installed fan removal rail. The fan removal rail shall be integrated in air handling unit design and construction, structurally robust to support the entire fan assembly, and facilitate the mounting of a hoist system to lift and remove fan assembly."

2. 23 73 13 – Air Handling Units, Part 3, Article 3.1 Installation, Add Paragraph P to read:

AHU INSTALLATION WITHIN EXISTING BUILDING

- Access and Dimensional Requirements
 - a. The largest section of each AHU shall be sized to pass through existing exterior door openings without removal of any factory-installed, tested, and balanced components.
 - b. AHU sections must be dimensioned to fit through mezzanine access points without requiring structural modifications to the building.
- 2. Manufacturer Scope of Work
 - a. Any dismantling and reassembly of AHU components shall be performed solely by the AHU manufacturer.
 - b. The manufacturer shall ensure that all reassembled units maintain original factory performance standards, including fan balance and component alignment.

- 3. Shipping and Handling
 - AHUs shall be shipped to the project site in preassembled sections sized for site access constraints.
 - b. Each section shall be clearly labeled and packaged to facilitate efficient handling and installation.
- 4. Contractor Responsibilities and Inspection Procedures
 - a. The contractor shall coordinate delivery schedules with the manufacturer to ensure timely access to the site and minimize disruption to other trades.
 - b. The contractor shall verify that all AHU sections received match the approved submittals and are free from damage prior to installation.
 - c. The contractor shall provide necessary equipment and labor to move AHU sections into position, following manufacturer guidelines.
 - d. Upon completion of reassembly by the manufacturer, the contractor shall witness and document final inspection and testing, including verification of airflow balance and mechanical integrity.
 - e. Any discrepancies or damage observed during handling or installation shall be reported immediately to the manufacturer and project manager for resolution.
